<b>Saturday 10 May</b> 10 am start Village Hall (3hrs)	<i>'The Quakers'</i> . Uffculme, Spiceland, Prescott, Culmstock, Ashill. Approx 12 miles.	
<b>Saturday 17 May</b> 10 am start Village Hall (3hrs)	<i>'OTT'</i> . Ashill, Bodmiscombe, Blackborough, Sainthill. Approx 8 miles (includes picnic!)
